We may look at a pro-athlete or prolific musician and say, "Wow I can't believe they did that. I'll never do that..."

Fundamental 4 is to combat this unspoken belief that others simply have different limits than us. WRONG. *Anything is possible*.

Let's focus on Drake for a moment, for he shared an interesting example of Fundamental 4.

Drizzy missed the mark on his next album, 'If You're Reading This It's Too Late,' which sold 495,000 copies in 2015. Then in 2016 he released the album 'Views'.

In it's first week in the United States, 'Views' moved 1.04 million album-equivalent units.

Album-equivalent units are what the Recording Industry Association of America (RIAA) defines as the streaming equivalent to physical or digital whole-album sales. So when Drake said he'd "sell a million first week", he could not have predicted that "sell" would change meanings between 2013 and 2016.

Yet, this helped him meet his goal. Drake knew anything was possible, and he allowed it to happen beyond how he thought it would.
